

Michel BAUZA is the North Africa Director of Business France in Tunis since September 2020. He coordinates the actions of Business France and Team France Export & Invest in the 4 countries of the region (Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, Libya), to

- 1) Strengthen the entrepreneurial and sectoral dynamics between the two shores of the Mediterranean
- 2) The attractiveness of France for international investors
- 3) Training young professionals internationally through the V.I.E programme

Between 2017 and 2022, he was in charge of the Volontariat International en Entreprise (V.I.E) and the Business France establishment in Marseille.

Between 2014 and 2016, he led the partnership between the Public Investment Bank (Bpifrance) and Business France in Paris, with the creation of the network of International Business Officers accompanying growth SMEs on French territory.

After a first multisectoral position in Algeria, Michel BAUZA began his professional career as an industrial manager at the Economic Mission of Algiers (1989-1994). He worked in the network of Economic Missions of French Embassies for 10 years, in the service of the internationalisation of companies in Chile - Santiago until 1999, then in Canada - Toronto until 2004.

At that time he was called back to France and worked for UBIFRANCE to set up the Marseilles office as part of the decentralisation of the operator. In 2007, he joined the network abroad again as Area Director for South-West Europe, based in Athens.

Michel BAUZA did his National Service as a CSNE (ancestor of the V.I.E) at the economic expansion post in Oran, Algeria.
